

Mountain Swimming League Constitution

Last Revised Spring 2000

Article I - Name

The name of the organization shall be THE MOUNTAIN SWIMMING LEAGUE.

Article II – PURPOSE

The purpose of the organization shall be to promote competitive swimming for boys and girls during the summer.

Article III – MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to any summer swimming organization in the area, which desires to field a team and abide by the constitution and rules of the organization. Application for membership shall be presented at the first League meeting of the new season, and a representative of the new team must be present. Acceptance shall require a three-fourths affirmative vote of those present. Each pool receives one vote.

Article IV – OFFICERS

The offices shall be president, treasurer, and secretary: Three (3) different teams must fill these offices. The offices of president and secretary shall rotate alphabetically every two (2) years, excluding Tyrone as long as Tyrone remains Treasurer. Officers shall be elected at the postseason meeting by a majority vote of those teams present. Term of office to run until the adjournment of the postseason meeting of the second year. Pools not represented by an officer will designate one member to represent and vote for them at meetings. Duties of officers shall be generally as follows:

PRESIDENT

1. Set up meetings
2. Conduct meetings
3. Form committees, if needed
4. Handle all problems and complaints
5. In the event of a tie, the president will cast the tiebreaker vote.

SECRETARY

1. Record the minutes of all meetings or appoint an acting secretary in his/her absence.
2. Make up meet schedule Y
3. Keep an up-to-date contact list of all League members including names, addresses & phone numbers.
4. Keep on file in a notebook copies of all minutes, the constitution, the treasurer's reports, order of events and meet schedules.
5. Provide copies of the above mentioned items for members with costs incurred to be reimbursed by the league.
6. Send out meeting notices to members.

TREASURER

1. Has custody of all the funds of the organization to be established in an interest bearing account.
2. Keep a full and accurate account of all receipts and expenditures.
3. Present a financial statement at every meeting of the organization and at other times upon request by the executive committee.

Article V – MEETINGS

The organizational meeting will be held on a Sunday during the month of April, not later than April 30" of each year, with at least two weeks advance notice.

The postseason meeting will be held on a Sunday no earlier than the Sunday following Championships and no later than August 31st. All other meetings to be held at the discretion of the league president during the season with no meetings to be held after 31st of August.

Article VI - CONSTITUTION CHANGES

Any proposed changes to the constitution shall be submitted at the first meeting of the season.

Article VII – RULE CHANGES

Rules may be changed or established by a three-fourths vote of those present at meetings.
